



Dear Parents,

It's almost time! Your child will soon be in school. A new stage in life will begin for both you and your child. At this point, you may have some questions or are unsure about school enrolment. To ensure that you are not left alone with these questions, our team of school doctors and socio-medical assistants would very much like to support you at this very important time by examining your child before he or she starts school.

Please bring the following to the medical (all compulsory):

- **Vaccination** book (since 01.01.2013, the presentation of existing vaccination documentation and certificates is **mandatory** in accordance with Article 14, Section 5, Sentence 8 GDVG)
- **Yellow booklet on the child care examinations (and an additional booklet/sheet for the U7a examination, if applicable)**
- **This form with completed rear side**

The details requested on the rear are voluntary and will remain at the Department of Health ("Gesundheitsamt"). We would, however, ask you to answer the questions carefully and in full, so that we can provide the best possible consultation for your child.

If your child has a **severely handicapped pass ("Schwerbehindertenausweis")** or a **health card ("Gesundheitspass")** such as an allergy card ("Allergiepass"), diabetes card ("Diabetikerausweis") or similar, or **glasses or hearing aid**, please bring these with you as well.

The School Entry Medical initially includes a "School Entry Screening" with eyesight, hearing, language and development tests performed by a socio-medical assistant **with all children**.

Where required, a medical examination and/or exploratory development diagnostics are subsequently carried out. **This school doctor examination of your child is required without fail if your child has not yet had or has missed the U9 Early Detection Medical (60th to 64th month). If your child has not yet had the U9, please have it performed soon by your pediatrician or family doctor.**

Please note:

The school must also be presented with a Department of Health confirmation of attendance at the School Entry Medical. Presentation of the yellow booklet at the school is not required! Attendance at the School Entry Medical is compulsory in accordance with Article 14 of the Law on Public Health and Consumer Protection and Article 80 of the Bavarian Law on Education and Teaching.

The anonymized results of the School Entry Medical in Bavaria are analyzed statistically (without name and address). This permits the collection of important information on the current state of child health in Bavaria.
